If you are taking the CGC, you will be given a time slot between 3:00 and 5:00 p.m. If you are taking the CGCA, you will arrange a time on Thursday with the evaluator, e-mail kbaileycooper@gmail.com

The CGC and CGCA are now considered AKC titles!!!

The test must be performed on leash. Dogs should wear well-fitting buckle or slip collars or body harnesses. No pinch, shock, head collars or other special training equipment is permitted. Leashes should be leather or fabric. No retractable leashes may be used. No food or toys are allowed to be used during the test. You may want to bring your own dog brush for the CGC test.

In order to participate for CGCA, the participant must have a CGC on file with AKC prior to testing.
