DNA Clinic

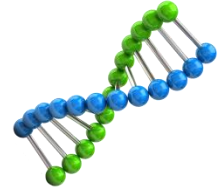

Bio

Dr. Battaglia who holds the Ph.D. and Master's degree from Florida State University. He is a breeder, author, researcher and lecturer. Dr Battaglia judges the Herding and Working Groups, three sporting breeds and the Chinese Shar pi. He has judged 11 national specialty shows and is considered one of the premiere judges of the AKC. He is also the author of research studies and several books. Many of his articles have appeared in the AKC Gazette, Dog World, Canine Chronicle, and Dog News and in publications throughout: Canada, Hungary, South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, Chile and Ireland. His research about Early Neurological Stimulation was published in the Journal of Veterinary Behavioral Science. His recent study on the Risk factors of bloat was published in the American Journal of Veterinary Medicine.



Dr. Battaglia has served on several important committees including the: The National Genetics Committee, The Canine Health and Education Committee, and AKC's Committee for the Future. He has appeared on the Animal Planet several times.
