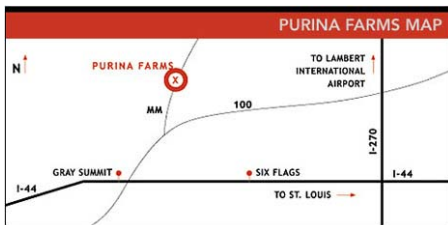

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

The following non-regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches
Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition

Veteran 7 Years and over Class - 7 Years and older on the day of the show

Entries in Veteran classes may NOT be spayed or neutered

Herding Titled Class - For intact Dogs or Bitches that have earned an AKC herding title.

The following titles do not apply: Instinct test certificate and any other non -AKC title.

Entries in Herding Titled class may NOT be spayed or neutered

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog cannot be shown as the Get for another Stud Dog.

The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class (Two dogs, one or more common owners) The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class" if more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2."

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION

RULES: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By Exhibitor from the Bred-By Exhibitor class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed/Variety Competition unless the Best Bred-By Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By Exhibitor class are eligible for the Best Bred-By Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Pair MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes - "Pairs Class".

Please Note: The other entry comprising the unit must be identified on the entry form for each dog. For online entries, the notation can be made in the "comments" field.

**According to Chapter 1, Section 27 of AKC Obedience Regulations and Chapter 1, Section 22 of the Rally regulations, entries will be limited. Each judge will be limited to a total of 8 hours of judging time per day. Obedience Trials will be limited as follows: Monday, each trial will be limited to 4 hours. Rally Trials will be limited as follows: Monday, each trial will be limited to 4 hours. When obedience and rally entries are limited, AKC requires that UDX and RAE classes are listed in the premium. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Open B or Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B the RAE class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted.

Most Versatile Miniature American Shepherd 2017 MV-MAS Rules (Board Approved)

PURPOSE: The Most Versatile Miniature American Shepherd (MV-MAS) Competition offered at a MASCUSA National Specialty recognizes those dogs that exemplify the true meaning of the word versatility by successfully competing in herding and companion competitions and meeting the AKC Miniature American Shepherd Breed Standard in the Versatility Conformation class.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all AKC registered Miniature American Shepherds, including neutered dogs and bitches. PAL/ILP dogs are ineligible. Bitches in heat will be allowed to run with possible restrictions (running last, wearing protective panties, etc.) to be determined by the Versatility Committee, as dictated by AKC Rules and Regulations, or, in their absence, the Versatility Chair.

To qualify in the Most Versatile Miniature American Shepherd Competition, a dog must:

- earn a qualifying score in the Versatility Conformation class,
- pass a Herding Test, pass the instinct test or have a herding title
- earn a qualifying score in at least one of the Companion classes (obedience, agility, or rally).
Although one qualifying companion score is required, a dog may receive three scores, one qualifying score from each of the companion categories.

Only scores from events designated as MV-MAS qualifying events in the Nationals Premium will count. (Having a herding title will be given points)

SCORING: Only qualifying scores in Conformation, Herding, Obedience, Rally and Agility will be counted.

CONFORMATION: This class will be held at a time and place designated by the National Specialty Show Committee. All dogs competing for the versatility awards will be judged against the AKC Miniature American Shepherd Breed Standard. One judge, who is eligible to judge or who has judged conformation, will judge the class. Details on ring procedure will be included in the premium each year.

MV-MAS Score will be computed as follows:

- The conformation score given by the judge – maximum 110 points.
- Dog must earn a minimum of 50 points to qualify in Conformation.

HERDING TESTS & TRIALS: COMBINED TOTAL OF TWO HIGHEST SCORES/POINTS FROM HERDING TESTED INCLUDING INSTINCT TEST, HERDING TESTED AND PRE-TRIAL TESTED OR TRIAL INCLUDING STARTED/INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED, SHEEP, CATTLE, OR DUCKS, ANY COURSE OFFERED. NON-QUALIFYING SCORES FROM THE “TRIAL” CLASSES CAN BE USED AS LONG AS DOG IS NOT RETIRED OR REMOVED.

MV-MAS Tested Scores will be computed as follows:

- Instinct Test: 20 points Must pass to get points
- Herding title : 25 (must be proven, either listed on AKC site or score sheets shown)
- Herding Test: 30 points
- Pre-Trial Test: 40 points

MV-MAS Trial Scores will be computed as follows

- Started raw score #1 + Started raw score #2
- Intermediate raw score #1 + Intermediate raw score #2 + 5 points
- Advanced raw score #1 + Advanced raw score # + 10 points

If dog is entered in both Trial & Tested, only the combined trial scores or combined tested points will be used, whichever is higher. If a dog qualifies on more than one type of stock or course, the two highest scores will apply for Trial Levels. When there are separate trials or courses for the different types of stock, these will be treated as one trial for MV-MAS purposes.

OBEDIENCE: 50% OF HIGHEST QUALIFYING SCORE INCLUDING BONUS FROM A REGULAR CLASS, PREFERRED OR GRAD

MV-MAS Scores will be computed as follows (only qualifying scores can be used):

Beginner Novice:	50% of raw score
Preferred Novice:	50% of raw score + 5 pts
Novice:	50% of raw score +10 pts
Grad Novice:	50% of raw score +15 pts
Preferred Open:	50% of raw score +20 pts
Open:	50% of raw score +25 pts
Grad Open:	50% of raw score +30 pts
Preferred Utility:	50% of raw score +35 pts
Utility:	50% of raw score +40 pts

RALLY: HIGHEST QUALIFYING SCORE INCLUDING BONUS FROM A REGULAR CLASS (NOVICE A & B, ADVANCED A & B or EXCELLENT A & B).

MV-MAS Scores will be computed as follows (only qualifying scores can be used):

- Novice: 50% of raw score
- Advanced: 75% of raw score plus 5 points
- Excellent: 100% of raw score plus 10 points

AGILITY: HIGHEST QUALIFYING SCORE INCLUDING BONUS FROM THE REGULAR STANDARD CLASS (for all dogs) OR PREFERRED STANDARD CLASS (only for dogs 7 years or older)

MV-MAS Scores will be computed as follows (only qualifying scores can be used):

- Novice: raw score
- Open: raw score + 5 points
- Excellent: raw score + 10 points

TIES: If there is a tie, highest combined herding score will be used. If there is still a tie, the highest movement score from the conformation evaluation will be used.

National's Special Awards

Ultimate American

The Ultimate American competition is offered to showcase the amazing abilities of the Miniature American Shepherd. Unlike the traditional MV-MAS program, Ultimate American, changes year to year, depending on which events are offered. A Miniature American Shepherd is attentive and animated, showing strength and stamina combined with unusual agility. The Miniature American Shepherd has Exceptional agility combined with strength and stamina allows for working over a variety of terrain. This highly versatile, energetic dog makes an excellent athlete with superior intelligence and a willingness to please those to whom he is devoted. Dogs must be AKC registered Miniature American Shepherds to participate.

New dog sports will be added in the future to further demonstrate the amazing abilities of the Miniature American Shepherd. Hosting clubs must offer at least 3 events.

ULTIMATE AMERICAN SCORING

To qualify for the Ultimate American (UA) in 2017, one must qualify in at least 3 of the following categories (any level including instinct) at Nationals: AKC Herding Instinct/Test/Trial, AKC Agility, AKC Obedience, AKC Rally Obedience, NADD Dock Diving, Disc Dog, and Fast CAT.

Placements will be awarded for 1st – 4th; and all UA qualifiers will receive an award. 1st Place winner will earn the title "Ultimate American". If the 1st place Ultimate American is also the 1st place dog for MV-MAS, they will be given the Iron Dog award. Iron Dog prize to be sent after Nationals, as there may or may not be a winner each year.

Point Calculation: Points are totaled from all event categories offered.

If there is a tie, the 1st tie-breaker is to take the most categories with a Q, 2nd tie-breaker is to take the highest Herding score, 3rd tie-breaker is to take the fastest Herding time and 4th tie breaker is the number of classes entered.

ULTIMATE AMERICAN SCORING

A scorekeeper/chairperson will be assigned by MASCUSA or the Hosting Club. Scores will be available for exhibitors to double check as soon as practicable after each eligible competition is completed. It is the owner/handler's responsibility to check the scores as posted, and report to the Ultimate American chairperson any discrepancy no later than 2 hours prior to the time scheduled for awarding Ultimate American. Discrepancies may only be filed by the handler for the event where there is a discrepancy. The Ultimate American awards will be presented at the Award Ceremony. Judges placements/decisions for all events are final. Awards for Ultimate American are final once presented. The Ultimate American Chairperson will keep records for at least 1 year after the event.

ULTIMATE AMERICAN ENTRANTS

Ultimate American entrants must be 6 months of age as of the 1st day of the competition, and AKC registered. Individual events may have additional age criteria.

Event Categories – only the highest score for each category will be used, except Agility will have JWW and Standard.

SPECIAL ULTIMATE AMERICAN RECOGNITION

Participating in the Ultimate American is an adventure in itself. A certificate will be awarded to recognize and encourage the following participants/dogs in addition to regular awards listed above: Junior Handler Awards - The handler must show the dog in all events in order to be eligible for Junior Handler awards. Multiple handlers may handle the dog for Veteran.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1887, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

In case of a medical emergency in the RV lot in the evening or during the night, please turn on the RV's outside lights to help responders identify the RV. **Call 314-982-2222 or 636-221-1428 to reach Purina security.**

Groups wishing to be next to one another should send reservations in the same envelope.

Exhibitors may not bring or use motorized vehicles, such as golf carts on Purina's property unless for a medical conditions. Documentation must be presented if requested by the staff at Purina. Such vehicles may not park on sidewalks.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
