Online Entries: This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be 350 runs online (50%), 350 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one. Coupons or vouchers will be accepted for mailed entries only and cannot be used for online entries.

Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable. No FAX entries accepted.

Limit of 10 dogs per envelope

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries.**

Miniature American Shepherd Only Restricted Period

From trial opening on 1/03/2025 until 1/31/2025 only entries for Miniature American Shepherds will be put into the trial. Entries for all other breeds will be put on a wait list in the order in which they were received. On 2/01/2025, all other entries will be added to the trial until the 700-run limit is reached, and the rest will be on a wait list.

Move-Ups

For the Tuesday, April 1st trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CT, Tuesday, March 25th, 2025. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent. For the Wednesday trial: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Tuesday and must be submitted at the trial.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification had been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (50 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on Friday, February 28, 2025. The waiting list will be active until its deadline – Tuesday, March 25th, 2025 at 6:00 pm CT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the runs.** Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. All contacts are rubberized.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) are eligible to participate, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Course Familiarization/Obstacles

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through may be split at the judge's discretion. The judge's briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials.

There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs at any of these trials.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height divisions. Judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trial. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program. Height divisions are as follows:

AKC Jump Height Cards

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs except those jumping 24" or 26" without jump height cards/forms must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class; this measurement will be valid for the weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial. If the dog cannot be measured by the VMO prior to running, it must be measured by the judge before its first run. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form if your dog needs to be measured.** For more information please visit: http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm

Notice to Exhibitors

Email, telephone, fax, and unsigned entries or entries without fees cannot be accepted.

Entries not on Official AKC Agility Entry without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry will NOT be accepted.

Express Mail Entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature.

Returned or postdated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

There will be a \$30 service charge for each returned check.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms correctly and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

Miniature American Shepherd Club of the United States of America (MASCUSA) may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against MASCUSA or any official thereof.

MASCUSA will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Puppies under the age of 4 months are strictly prohibited from the premises.

Unentered dogs and bitches in season will not be permitted on the premises.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of judge or show committee.

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the Trial. Entry fee (minus \$15) will be refunded for bitches in heat. Notification must be received 24 hours before the start of judging.

Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. MASCUSA assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warmup area.

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Please clean up after your dog. Receptacles will be provided.

Overpayments of fees less than \$10 will be considered a donation to the club and will not be returned.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend

Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

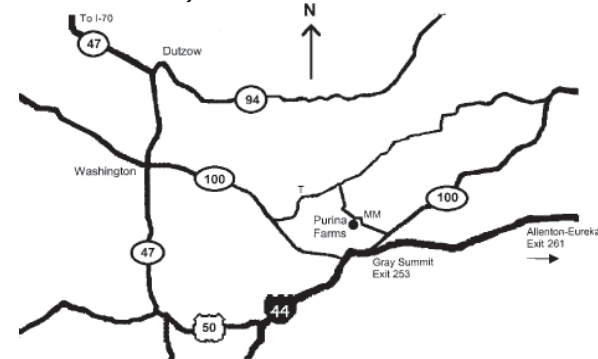
For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only will Not be offered at this trial.

Routes to the Show Site

From North/East/South: Take I-44 to Gray Summit/Hwy 100 Exit 253. Turn east on Hwy 100. After approximately 0.5 mile, turn left on MM at gas station. Entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 0.5 mile on left, just past the herding field.

From West: Take I-70 to Hwy 47, Exit 193. Take Hwy 47 south to Hwy 100. Continue on 100 to I-44 east. Take I-44 east one exit to Gray Summit. Follow the directions above.



AWARDS and TROPHIES:

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class, provided that they have earned qualifying scores. New Title Rosettes will also be available for those earning those honors.

- Rosettes and “MACH Bars” will be awarded for those earning a MACH title

- Rosette will be awarded for those earning their Agility Grand Championship

Overall Highest Scoring Junior Handler – Overall High scoring, Junior Handler team, both days combined. Rosette and Crystal Trophy

Regular/Preferred/A Class/B Class will compete for the same level.
Only Qualifying Runs will be used.

The formula for calculating Levels will be:

- Novice – 6 points for each qualifying run (All Standard and All JWW)
- Open – 7 points for each qualifying run (All Standard and All JWW)
- Excellent – 8 points for each qualifying run (All Standard and All JWW)
- Master – 8 points for each qualifying run (All Standard and All JWW)

The formula for calculating Overall will be: Highest Total Points plus bonus points. If there is a tie, then the YPS will be calculated using all runs, (Std and JWW)

The Formula for calculating the Overall High scoring Dog from the Fast Class:

All levels combined. Bonus points will be awarded to calculate this as follows. Novice – Raw score, Open – 5 Bonus Points, Excellent and Masters will receive 10 bonus points. All Bonus points will be added to the number of points scored in the Fast Class. If there is a tie, total time will be used. Example: Open dog scores 74 points, plus 5 bonus points for a total of 79. Master dog has a score of 68 plus 10 bonus points, for a total of 78. Then the overall score of 79 will win the award.

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended.
